Rep. Garner’s Pro-Life Record

2007

Voted For HB2768: Affirming the Right of a Woman to Refuse to Have an Abortion

Prevents husbands, boyfriends, or parents from forcing a woman or girl to have an abortion against her will.

Voted For HB2416: Creating a Cord Blood Bank Commission

Established a commission that will work to establish Arkansas’ first umbilical cord blood bank. Cord blood may be used as a source of stem cells rather than destroying human embryos to obtain embryonic stem cells, making it a promising pro-life solution.

Voted For SB398: Creating a Certificate of Birth for Stillborn Children

Permits parents of stillborn children to obtain a birth certificate for their child. This law was another step in affirming the personhood of unborn and newborn children.

2009

Voted For HB1113: The Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act

Prohibited partial-birth abortions in Arkansas.

2011

Voted For HB1855: Requiring All Facilities that Perform 10 or More Abortions Each Month to be Licensed by the Dept. of Health

Co-Sponsored SB113: To Prohibit Health Insurance Exchange Policies from Offering Coverage for Abortions
